Albert H. Felty, 85, of 332 Church Street, Annville died Saturday April 7, 2012 in Cedar Haven Nursing Home, Lebanon. He was the husband of Myrl Deininger Felty with whom he would have celebrated their 63rd Wedding Anniversary this August. Born in Pine Grove on May 18, 1926, he was the son of the late John H. Felty and the late Eva May Kreiser Felty Posey. He was the founding owner and operator of Albert H. Felty Building Contractor retiring in 1991 and was a US Army Veteran of WW II.
