Allen R. Sheffy was born May 11, 1938 in Cleona, Pennsylvania and was the son of the late Allen L. and Evelyn Zimmerman Sheffy. He married Patricia E. Witman on September 7, 1957 and together they celebrated their 55th Wedding Anniversary. After graduating in 1956 from Lebanon High School, he served for three years in the US Army at Ft. Ricker, Alabama and Fort George G. Meade, MD. Allen retired from Met-Ed in 1994 after 29 years of service. He also worked part-time for the Cleona Borough Police for 12 years and served as a deputy sheriff for the Lebanon County Sheriff's Department. Allen loved the Atlanta Braves, Pittsburgh Steelers, Philadelphia Flyers, and the Hershey Bears. He sang in the Singing Cedar Chorus and with the "Sound of Renown" barbershop quartet for over 25 years with Ed Matthews, Dean Kahl, and Norm Wilson. Allen was a member of Mt.
