



## Amos F. Seiders III

Amos F. “Moose” Seiders, III, 55, of Lebanon died Monday, August 7, 2017 in the M.S. Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Tracie L. Mraz Seiders with whom he would have celebrated their 31st wedding anniversary this September.
