Ann M. Lingle, 83, of Annville, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by her loving family on Sunday, April 13, 2014.

Born in Lebanon on September 30, 1930, she was the daughter of the late George L. and Lucy B. Arnold Shuey. Ann was a 1948 graduate of Lebanon Catholic High School and a 1951 graduate of St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing in Lancaster. Ann was a registered nurse at the Good Samaritan Hospital for 25 years and at the VA Medical Center for 17 years. She was a member of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church, Annville, where she especially enjoyed her Wednesday morning faith-sharing group.

Ann enjoyed bus trips with NARFE and traveling to the beach, where she hosted her entire family each summer.
