



## Anthony A. "Tony" Ficco

July 12, 1940 - March 15, 2018

Anthony A. "Tony" Ficco, Jr., 77, of Myerstown, passed away on Thursday March 15, 2018 at Spang Crest Manor in Lebanon. He was the husband of Frances M. Ficco, who recently passed away in February of this year.

Tony was born in Lebanon on July 12, 1940 to the late Anthony A. Ficco, Sr., and Marie (Frazier) Ficco. He was a 1958 graduate of Lebanon Catholic High School. Since 1954 Tony and his family had owned Ficco Memorials until it's closing. For 30 years, Tony had been a professional firefighter for the City of Lebanon. He was the engineer for the Perseverance truck throughout his career and continued on even after retirement. He also had been with the First Aid and Safety Patrol for 30 plus years. He was a member of St. Cecilia's Catholic Church, Rotary, and an associate member of the Fraternal Order of the Police. He was also an Eagle Scout and very active with Camp Baeshore. Tony had a passion for photography. He attended Rochester Institute of Technology where he earned his Arson/Criminal Investigation certificate. He used his training in investigative photography assisting both the PA State Police and City of Lebanon. He often submitted his photos to the local newspapers. For many years he donated his time and photos to the Lebanon High School yearbook. He loved photographing nature. Tony and his wife enjoyed traveling and cruising. Tony was a "Jack of all trades, Master of most." He loved woodworking and collecting tools.

He is survived by his children, Ann D'Orazio of Lebanon, Rita Ficco of Phoenix, AZ, Anthony A. "Andy" Ficco and his wife Amy of Myerstown, and his

four granddaughters, Rachel, Hannah, Emily, and Julia. He was preceded in death by his brother Robert M. Ficco.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Tuesday, March 20, 2018 at 11AM from St. Cecilia's Catholic Church, 120 E. Lehman Street, Lebanon. Interment will be in Holy Cross Cemetery, Lebanon. There will be a viewing held from 9:30AM until 11AM at the church.
