



## Archie R. Battistelli

June 11, 1945 - June 12, 2013

Archie R. Battistelli, Jr., 68, of Annville died Wednesday June 12, 2013 in the M. S. Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Patricia J. Spangler Battistelli with whom he was married 33 years. Born in Latrobe, PA on June 11, 1945, he was the son of the late Archie and Mary Gasperini Battistelli. He was currently a Sr. Vice-President at Stifel Nicolaus, Lebanon. His former employment included Regional Vice-President of Dauphin Deposit Bank and Vice-President of the former Hershey Bank. Archie was a 1963 graduate of Lebanon High School and attended banking school at Bucknell University and the University of Delaware. He was a member of Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Church, Lebanon, past president and chairman of the golf committee of the Lebanon Kiwanis Club, Board of the Lebanon Valley Economic Development Corp., Visiting Nurses Association Board of Directors, Lebanon Library Board, and former Chairman of the Board of the Lebanon Valley Chamber of Commerce. Battistelli and wife Julie Hetrick Battistelli, grandchildren, Ella, Alicia, Marissa, and Maria Battistelli, Erin and Alison Forker, two brothers Donald Battistelli and wife Louise Brossman Battistelli, Kenneth Battistelli and wife Bonita Reese Battistelli, two nephews Kenneth Battistelli, Christopher Battistelli, and a niece Gina Battistelli Barb who was also his God daughter. preceded in death by a nephew Todd Battistelli..
