Barbara J. Hess was born in Fairview Township, Mifflin County, Pennsylvania on February 28, 1938. She was the daughter of Howard B. Steele and Curlie Ellen (Wagner) Steele. She graduated from Lewistown High School in 1956 and received a bachelor's degree at Messiah College in 1960. After working as the Girl's program director at the Lewistown YMCA, she began her teaching career in the Redland School District in January of 1961. On June 10, 1961, she married the love of her life, Glenn I. Hess, in the Messiah College Chapel in Grantham, PA. Barbara was a school teacher her entire life. After teaching in the Redland School District, the Mechanicsburg School District and the Chambersburg School District, Barbara moved to the Lebanon School District. Barbara taught at the Lebanon School District from 1968 until her retirement in 2000. Even after retiring, Barbara continued as a substitute teacher for an additional four years. Teaching children was an important part of her life.
