



Barry L. Rohrer

June 23, 1946 - January 7, 2018

Barry L. Rohrer, 71, of Myerstown, passed away on Sunday, January 7, 2018, surrounded by his loving family. He was the husband of Loretta J. (Becker) Rohrer, with whom he celebrated 39 years in marriage.

Barry was born in Harrisburg on June 23, 1946. He had worked for various employers as a union carpenter. Barry was a member of Zion Gosherts UCC. He was also a member of Mt. Olivet Lodge #704, Myerstown Rod & Gun Club, a lifetime member of the American Legion #51, and the VFW. He was the former president of Pine Grove Antique Car Club. Barry was a U.S. Navy Veteran of the Vietnam War, where he served for 4 years. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1965-1969. He served on the USS Kenebeck AO36 until 1968, where he was a 3rd class boatswains. He then served on the USS Mataco ATF86 and was discharged after 11 months. He had served four tours during the Vietnam War on the Saigon River, where he worked in salvage and towing. He was instrumental in getting the Vietnam Veteran License Plate passed in Pennsylvania. Barry contacted the senators to get this license plate process started. He was also honored at the capital for this accomplishment. Barry was an antique and classic car enthusiast and loved riding his motorcycle. Barry was the kind of gentleman that anyone who knew him, loved him.

Affectionately known as Papa to his family, he is also survived by his children Debra wife of Clarence Heffner and Robin wife of Ernest "Ernie" Kleinfelter; two grandchildren, Candy Hummel & Shelby Koch; four great grandchildren,

Austin, Trevor, Andrew & Sarah; and a great-great grandson Mark. He was preceded in death by his son Robert Dibble.

Graveside services will be held on Friday, January 12, 2018, at 2:00 p.m. at the Indiantown Gap National Cemetery, E. Hanover Twp. There will be a procession forming at 1:30 p.m. at the Creamer & Lum Funeral Home, Rt. 72 & Camp Meeting Rd., Jonestown. There will be no viewing or visitation before the graveside services.
