Betty Lou Colban, 82, of 101 Walnut Street East, Cleona died Monday October 19, 2015 in the Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon. She was the wife of the late Peter N. Colban.

Born in Lairdsville, PA on April 23, 1933, she was the daughter of the late Milard B. and Anna M. Fornwalt Smith. She was employed as a Nurse Anesthetist at the Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon and then in the Apheresis Department at the M. S. Hershey Medical Center.
