Beverly A. "Mimi" Smith, 87, of Lebanon passed away on Wednesday June 26, 2024 at WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital. She was the wife of Lloyd R. 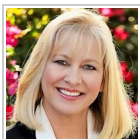
