Blake A. Lutz, 56, of Pine Grove, passed away on Friday, December 2, 2016, at the University of Pennsylvania Medical Center. He was the husband of Mary Dot Guides Lutz. On March 21st, they celebrated their 23rd wedding anniversary. Born at the Bethesda Naval Hospital on January 7, 1960, he was the son of the late John "Jack" and Kathleen Orfino Lutz.
