



## Bradley D. Stocker

Bradley D. Stocker, 75, of Cleona passed away Sunday, May 31, 2026 at M.S. Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of the late Laura (Baker) Stocker who passed away in 2016.

Born in Easton, Pennsylvania, he was a son of the late Lester H. and Kathryn L. (Porter) Stocker. Brad graduated from Phillipsburg High School in 1969, Lebanon Valley College and earned his master's degree in education from Millersville University. He retired from Annville-Cleona School District after 33 years as a 6th grade teacher, a math teacher and teacher in the gifted and talented program. Brad's interests included directing and performing for the Lebanon Valley College Summer Dinner Theatre, ENCORE Musical Productions, and the Lebanon Community Theatre where he also served on the board, directed and performed in shows, and served as the box office manager. Brad was also the director for the Annville-Cleona High School plays and musicals.

He is survived by two brothers Stephen A. Stocker and his wife Carol and Barry K. Stocker and his wife Margaret; seven nieces and nephews Christine, wife of Eric Winnicky, Mark Stocker, Erin, wife of Dan Church, Meredith, wife of Mike Durant, Gregory Stocker and his wife Stephanie, Lester R. Stocker, and Susan Grube; five great-nieces and nephews. Brad was preceded in death by a brother Lester E. Stocker.
