Bruce Leo Galli, 73, of Lebanon, passed away Sunday, November 21, 2021, at the WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital with his wife by his side.

Born in Pittston on March 28, 1948, he was the son of the late Leo and Josephine Ferraro Galli.

Bruce wasn't the loudest one in the room, but when he spoke, he made his words count. His family will always remember him as serious and silly wrapped in one. A combination that made family get-togethers hard to leave and never forget.

He was an active member of his church community, serving as financial secretary of the Church of the Good Shepherd. In his younger years, he was an avid skier, sailor and enjoyed playing pool.
