



## Carl R. Baum

October 3, 1925 - July 1, 2011

Carl R. Baum, 85, of 218 Community Circle, Lebanon Valley Brethren Home, Palmyra, died Friday, July 1, 2011, in the Home. He was the husband of Shirley C. F. Baum. Born in Derry Twp., on October 3, 1925, he was the son of the late Morris and Clara Holsberg Baum. He was the retired President of Bomberger's Bologna Company and also worked at the Lebanon Steel Foundry for 10 years. Carl was a U.S. Navy Veteran of WW II, serving on a destroyer in the South Pacific. He graduated from Hershey High School in 1943, Lebanon Valley College in 1950, with a degree in Chemistry and Biology, and received his Associates degree, from Hershey Junior College.
