Carl E. Blouch, 78, of Annville died Monday, November 22, 2021 in his residence. He was the husband of Earlene A. Kuntz Blouch with whom he would have celebrated their 57th wedding anniversary this December 12th. Born in Lebanon on October 10, 1943, he was the son of the late Harry and Sara Runkle Blouch. He retired from Tyco Electronics and prior to that, worked 25 years for Quaker Alloy, Myerstown and also for Kraft Foods, Palmyra.

Carl was a 1962 graduate of Lebanon High School. He was affectionately known as “Poppy” to his grandchildren and was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed hunting, fishing, boating and spending time with his children and grandchildren.
