Carl F. Kreider, 88, of Lebanon died Friday March 16, 2012 in the Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon. Carl was a member of Tabor United Church of Christ, Lebanon where he was Sunday School secretary for many years. He enjoyed helping people, traveling, camping and tending to his garden.
