



## Carmine Izzo

February 13, 1934 - January 23, 2021

Carmine Izzo, 86, of Cleona died Saturday, January 23, 2021 in his residence. He was the husband of Barbara Ann Handley Izzo with whom he celebrated 60 years of marriage this past October.

Born in Salerno, Italy on February 13, 1934, he was the son of the late Anthony and Concetta DiDomenico Izzo. He served in the Pennsylvania U.S. Army National Guard at Ft. Indiantown Gap as a calibration technician for 31 years attaining the rank of Master Sgt.
