Carolyn Jane Woods, 91, of Lebanon died on Saturday December 17, 2016 at Spang Crest Manor. She was the wife of the late Glenn H. Woods; he died on January 16, 2013.

Born in Laureldale, on April 22, 1925 she was the daughter of the late The Rev. Mark & Blanche (Morgan) Trexler. She was a graduate of Kutztown State Teachers College, a teacher at Cumberland Valley School District, Muhlenburg Township High School and taught English as a second language for the Annville Cleona School District until her retirement. Carolyn was a member of St. Mark Lutheran Church, Annville; she helped with church luncheons & education committee, taught in LCW women's group. She was a member of Home Study Circle, Annville, and lifetime member of Lebanon County Educational Honor Society, LVC Women's Auxiliary, friends of Old Annville and was a 4H leader. Carolyn was involved with students and families in Annville of Vietnamese and Cambodian descent, enjoyed PA German history and helped to start a cuisine club with her late husband.
