



## Charles W. Fackler

December 4, 1919 - April 8, 2010

Charles W. Fackler, Sr., 90, of 2718 Horseshoe Pike, Palmyra died Thursday April 8, 2010 in Hospice of Lancaster County, Mt. Joy. He was the husband of Anna Mae Dupler Fackler with whom he would have celebrated their 70th Wedding Anniversary this August. Born in Palmyra on December 4, 1919, he was the son of the late Aaron E. and Emma Gipe Fackler. He was previously employed as a truck driver for PA Farm Bureau and then retired as assistant manager after 45 years with Agway, Lebanon. He was a US Navy Veteran of WW II, a member of the Annville Church of the Brethren, and a lifetime member of the Bellegrove Fire Company. Surviving in addition to his wife are two sons Charles W. Fackler, Jr. and wife Carolyn of Woodstown, NJ, Edward L. Fackler and wife Sue of Pittsburgh, a daughter Elsie M. wife of Winston L. He was preceded in death by two brothers Lester A. and Earl Leroy Fackler, a sister Dorothy Manari, and a step-mother Edna Balmer Fackler.
