Charles G. "Rocky" Rockwell, 92, of Palmyra died on Thursday August 23, 2012 at his residence. He was the husband of Marina Garcia Rockwell to whom he was married for 56 years. Born in Dover, NJ on October 31, 1919 he was the son of the late Charles S. and Cora Mae Winters Rockwell. He graduated from Pompton Lake High School and Patterson Business College. Charles proudly served his country during WWII in the US Army. He was an office manager at the National Cash Register Company in Fairlawn, NJ. He was a member of the First Evangelical Congregational Church, Palmyra, a deacon in the Calvary Bible Church in West Milford, NJ and was active in the Passaic County Child Evangelism Fellowship. Rocky enjoyed collecting coins, fishing and gardening.
