Clair E. Bubb, 95, of Lake Placid, NY, went to be with Jesus on Monday, June 3, 2024, at his son's home in Jonestown. He was the husband of Virginia F. (Faxon) Bubb. They have been inseparable for the past 73 years and would have celebrated their 74th wedding anniversary on August 12, 2024.
