Clarence M. Risser, 96, of Palmyra, passed away on Wednesday January 24, 2018 at The Gardens of Palmyra. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Anna Mary Stover Risser, who passed away in 1991 and his second wife, Helen Strauss Risser, who passed away in 2006.

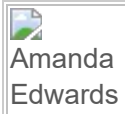
