Clyde E. Boltz, 88, of 603 Huckleberry Lane, Lebanon died Tuesday March 23, 2010 in the Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon. He was the wife of Shirley Klepper Boltz with whom he celebrated their 56th Wedding Anniversary this past January. Born in Lebanon on September 3, 1921, he was the son of the late Andrew Boltz and the late Mamie Herb Boltz Kreiser.
