Craig Flory, 74 of Palmyra passed away on Friday March 18, 2022 at his residence. He was the husband of the Susan L. (Hetrick) Flory, with whom he celebrated 48 years in marriage.

He was a self-employed photographer for Flory Photography Studio. Craig was a member of Trinity United Church of Christ. He was also a member on the 250th committee of Palmyra and Palmyra Businessman's Association. He was a lifetime member of the Professional Photographer Association of PA. His passion was photography, and he also enjoyed bowling.
