Curtis L. Shollenberger, Sr., 81, of Chadds Ford, died on April 15, 2017 at Twin Pines Health Care Center, West Grove. He was the husband of Marilyn (Roberts) Shollenberger they would have celebrated their 59th wedding anniversary on July 19, 2017.
