Dale R. Elliott, 69, of Palmyra died Friday, December 11, 2020 in his residence. He was the husband of Fay E. Logan Elliott with whom he celebrated 44 years of marriage this past August.

Born in Hershey on December 21, 1950, he was the son of the late Claude C. and Mary Wolfe Elliott. He retired from the Hershey Tech Center and formerly worked for Kraft Foods, Palmyra and for Hershey Foods Corp. Dale was a U.S. Army veteran of Vietnam and a 1969 graduate of Palmyra High School. He was a member of the Campbelltown American Legion, AARP, American Motorcycle Association, Lebanon Valley Motorcycle Club, Blue Mt. HOG Group where he held several offices, and a lifetime member of HOG (Harley Owners Group).
