Dale S. "Chappie" Chapman, 100, of Lebanon, passed away on Saturday, September 5, 2020 at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of the late Margaret J. Chapman, who passed away in 1992.

Chappie was born in Celina, Ohio on April 11, 1920 to the late Vernon and Eva (Houts) Chapman. He enlisted in the US Army at 21, and he served from 1941-1945.
