Daniel J. Wenger, Jr., 83, of the Kindred Place, Annville and formerly of Fredericksburg, passed away on Sunday, August 14, 2016, at WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital.

Born in Fredericksburg on August 27, 1932, he was the son of the late Daniel J. and Ada Bachman Wenger. He retired from the Lebanon Post Office where he had been a mail carrier. He was a member of the St. John's United Church of Christ, Fredericksburg and was a US Army veteran and served in France in the Signal Corp. He was Vice President of the Fredericksburg Pennsylvania Oberholtzer Association, and Dan had volunteered as the groundskeeper of the Grove Cemetery where four generations of his family is buried.

He was the last of his immediate family.
