Danielle A. Garrett, 29, of New Cumberland and formerly of Lebanon, died unexpectedly of natural causes on Thursday June 21, 2018 in her residence. Born in Lebanon on August 29, 1988, she was the daughter of Phillip E. Garrett and the late Christie-Lyn Hansell Garrett. Danielle was employed as a speech therapist at Forest Park Health Center.

Danielle was a 2006 graduate of Cedar Crest High School. She received her bachelor's degrees in speech therapy and psychology from California University of Pennsylvania and a master's degree in speech therapy from West Chester University.

She enjoyed swimming, kick-boxing, weight lifting, kayaking, going on cruises, taking silly selfies, and eating healthy, all the while aspiring to be a glittery mermaid. She loved cats, especially her Zoey. Her thoughtful nature was so evident in the creative handmade gifts that she enjoyed making for people. Her family and friends were the most important to her.

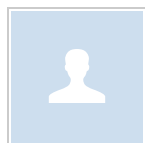

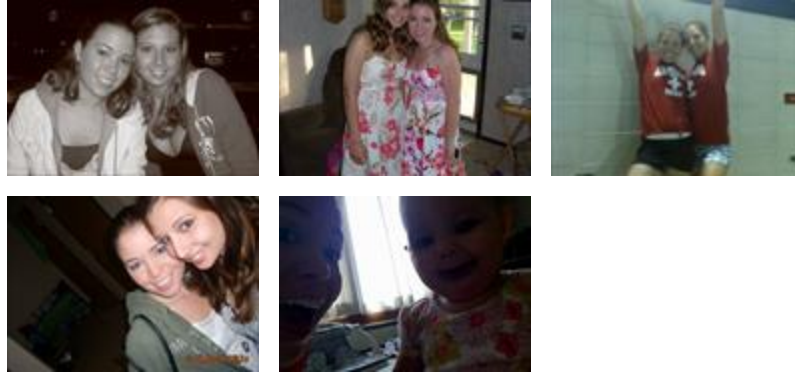

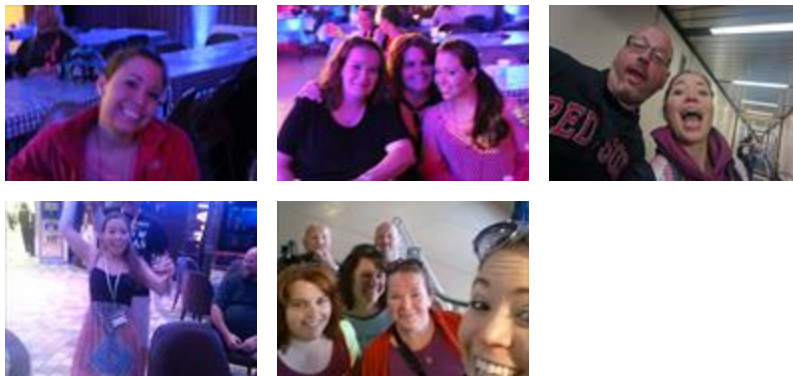
