David H. Haldeman, 86, of Lebanon, passed away on Saturday, January 28, 2023, at his home. He was the husband of Shirley A. Sholley Haldeman. On November 23rd, they celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary.

Born in Jackson Twp. on May 30, 1936, he was the son of the late John and Eva Gundrum Haldeman. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict. He attended the Lebanon Valley Bible Church.
