He was a member of the United Christian Church where he pastored 9 churches during his 43 years of service, serving the past 7 years as Bishop. He was an active member of the Mission Board taking numerous trips to Jamaica. He was a dairy farmer in South Annville Twp. For more than 40 years and later became a crop farmer. He was a Sales Rep for Dupont Pioneer Seed Co. for 48 years. In addition to his wife, with whom he celebrated their 52nd wedding anniversary in April, he is survived by 4 Children, Allen, husband of Eileen (Eberly), Lebanon; Marlin, husband of Jen (Jordan), Lebanon; Wayne, husband of Jen (Bucks), Bath, NY; and Janet, wife of Adam Montgomery, Lebanon.
