David L. Troup, 83, of Fredericksburg, passed away on Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at his home. He was the husband of Tyna D. (Snook) Troup. On October 9th, they celebrated their 59th wedding anniversary.

Born in Beaver Springs on November 13, 1942, he was the son of the late Charles F. and Dorothy P. (Aumiller) Troup. Following high school, he served with a MASH unit in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Conflict and served in Korea during that time. 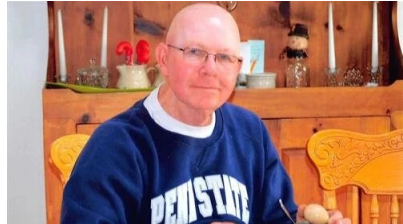
