Dean F. Keener, Sr., 69, of Mt. Wilson, passed away on Monday June 17, 2014, at the Rest Haven Nursing Home, Schuylkill Haven. He was the husband of Sandra L. Wagner Keener. On July 2nd, they would have celebrated their 37th wedding anniversary.
