



## Dennis M. Brehm

Dennis M. Brehm, 61, passed away on Sunday March 8, 2015 surrounded by his loving family at his residence. He is survived by his wife of 37 years, Dorothy “Dottie” A. Brown Brehm.

Born in Lebanon on March 18, 1953, he was the son of Benjamin and Evelyn Mohler Brehm of Palmyra. Dennis was a 1975 graduate of the Pennsylvania State University where he received a BS in forest science and was a brother of Tau Phi Delta, a forestry fraternity. He was employed by Weaber Inc. in the hardwood lumber business for the last 38 years, most recently in the position of Director of Forestry. He was a member of the Society of American Foresters and was the Vice Chair of the Pennsylvania SFI Implementation Committee. A member of the First United Methodist Church in Palmyra, Dennis also frequently attended St. Paul the Apostle Roman Catholic Church in Annville. He was very active within Boy Scout Troop # 432 in Jonestown. His interests included camping, backpacking, hunting, fishing and woodworking.

Surviving in addition to his wife and parents are his children, Michael Brehm of Annville and Kelley Brehm of Jonestown. He is also survived by his sister, Linda Schindler of Glide, Oregon.
