Donald Kocher Anglemeyer, 87, of Annville passed away Friday September 19, 2014 at Hill Farm Estates. He was the husband of Helen M. Bardwell Anglemeyer, with whom he celebrated 66 years of marriage this past May.

Born in Bangor, PA on July 20, 1927, he was the son of the late Harold and Mary E. Kocher Anglemeyer. A World War II Navy veteran, Donald was graduated from Lebanon Valley College with a bachelor's degree in business administration and economics. While there, he played tackle on the football team in 1947, which was the first year that Andy Kurr coached. His most memorable play was blocking an extra point to win the first game of the season. Donald was a member of the Palmyra First United Methodist Church, the Palmyra American Legion, the Palmyra Jaycees, and a charter member of the Palmyra Jr. Chamber of Commerce. He was a supervisor at Millard's Limestone Plant and a N. Londonderry Twp. supervisor. His interests included watching sports and traveling. Donald and his wife had been to 7 countries in Europe, the 48 contiguous states, and Canada.

In addition to his wife, Helen, he is survived by a son, Dale E. Anglemeyer and

wife Betsy of Lewes, DE, a daughter, Donna J.
