



Dr. Donald Gordon Crawford

July 6, 1937 - May 6, 2017

Donald G Crawford MD, beloved husband of Ann Stotsenburg Crawford, went peacefully to his eternal rest on May 6, 2017. Donald was born in Pennsauken, NJ on July 6, 1937, and is preceded in death by his parents and brother and sister. At the age of 7, Donald contracted bulbar polio and endured many months in an iron lung and Sister Kenny treatments. He went on to graduate from Wheaton College in 1959 and Hahnemann Medical College in 1963, and became a caring and competent physician. He practiced medicine for many years at Locust Lane Medical Center in Harrisburg and served as assistant clinical professor in the department of family and community medicine at the Pennsylvania State University College of Medicine. He was a past president of the Dauphin County Medical Society and a member of the Pennsylvania Medical Society. He was certified by the American Board of Family practice and held memberships in the American Medical Association, the Pennsylvania and American Academies of Family Physicians and the Harrisburg Society of diplomats. He was a diplomate of the National Board of Medical Examiners.

In addition to his wife of 57 years, he is survived by daughters Donna Crawford Brinser (Rick), Lori Crawford-Dixon (Dave) and Liesl Crawford Keener (Scott), as well as 6 grandchildren.

Donald was a former elder at Pine Street Presbyterian church in Harrisburg,

and a member of Grace Episcopal church in Charleston, SC. Upon returning to the north, he became a member of St. Luke's Episcopal in Lebanon.

Donald loved music, playing the trumpet, piano and for 30 years, the bagpipe. He was a member of the York Kiltie Band for 9 years and was proud of his Scottish heritage.

Donald was a faithful husband, father and granddad and cherished his time with family, especially the years spent together at Seabrook Island, SC. We will miss him so.
