Donald F. "Don" Kofler, 80, of Lebanon, passed away on Friday, October 25, 2019, at his residence. He was the husband of Patricia L. (Granger) Kofler, with whom he celebrated 60 years in marriage.

Don was born in Lebanon on May 17, 1939, to the late Harry R. and Doris E. (Mease) Kofler. He graduated from Penn State University with a degree in engineering. 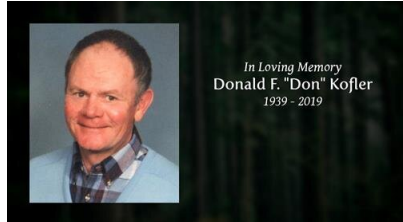
