Donald R. Murray, 82, of Palmyra formerly of Tucson, AZ died Tuesday March 6, 2012 at Columbia Cottage. He was the husband of Antje Bons Murray to whom he was married to for 48 years. Born in Springfield, MA on April 18, 1929 he was the son of the late Harold J. and Anna M. Hughes Murray. Don was a graduate of Rutland High School in Rutland, VT and Chapparral Career College in Tucson, AZ where he received his degree in Business Administration. After 25 years of military service Don retired from the US Air Force as a Tech Sergeant and proudly served his country in the Korean and Vietnam Wars. Don was employed by the VA Medical Center in Tucson, AZ for 20 years as a telecommunications coordinator. He was a former member of Christ Church United Methodist in Tucson, AZ and a present member of Church of the Good Shepherd in Lebanon. In addition to his wife Antje he is survived by a daughter Yvonne E. wife of Michael Roberts of Rexmont; one sister Roberta A. wife of Thomas Proffitt of Poultney, VT and one step-grandson Anthony C. Roberts. Donald was preceded in death by a son Norman R. Murray and a brother Harold J.
