



## Donald D. Wolfe

October 23, 1920 - March 19, 2018

World War II veteran, Donald D. Wolfe, 97, of Lebanon, passed away on Monday, March 19, 2018, at his home. Don was a U.S. Army veteran and served in Germany during WW II. He was the husband of Pauline M. Fortna Wolfe. They would have celebrated their 62nd wedding anniversary on June 30th.

Born in Ephrata on October 23, 1920, he was the son of the late Evan and Florence Romig Wolfe. He was an active member of the Bunker Hill Evangelical Congregational Church and he was formerly a member of the Lebanon Gospel Center. For almost 30 years he had worked as a soft drink delivery driver. He loved playing tennis, hockey and bowling. He was an avid Hershey Bears and a Phillies fan.
