Dorothy P. Goff, 78, of Jonestown passed away on Tuesday, December 4, 2018, in Lebanon. She was the wife of the late James W. "Bill" Goff, and they were married for 45 years until he passed away on May 31, 2005.

Born in Pittsburgh on September 13, 1940, she was the daughter of the late Leo R. and Dorothy P. (McGee) Clarke. She graduated from Bridgeville High School with the Class of 1958.
