



## Earl R. Lehman

March 21, 1928 - January 31, 2018

Earl Richard Lehman, age 89, passed away on Wednesday, January 31, 2018, at his farmhouse north of Palmyra. His energetic, hard-working body was worn out. He was born on March 21, 1928, in Palmyra to Brandt and Anna (Goodman) Lehman. He was the seventh of ten children. Earl was a farmer his whole life and owned and operated Lehman's Dairy and Vegetable Farm Market north of Palmyra for 48 years. He was well known for the many varieties of sweet corn and vegetables that he grew. He was also the superintendent and caretaker of Gravel Hill Cemetery for many years. He was a long standing member of the Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, a charter member of the Annville Area Lions Club, the Hershey Coin Club, and the Studebaker Club.

Earl married Edith Mae Wenger on January 29, 1949. They were married 61 years until her death in 2010. They were blessed with seven children: Donna Smith (Thomas) of Orem, Utah; Karen Lehman of Annville; Dennis Lehman (Bonnie) of Little River, South Carolina; David Lehman (Debra) of Palmyra; Susan Tucker (Thomas) of Cornwall; Anita Alt (Gene) of Annville; and Thomas Lehman (Beth) of Annville. In addition to his children, he is survived by 16 grandchildren, 22 great grandchildren, and sisters Ruth Bucher and Jean Witmer.
