



## Eden D. Fry

June 10, 1920 - December 5, 2011

Eden D. Fry, 91, of Palmyra and formerly of Mechanicsburg died Monday December 5, 2011 at the Lebanon Valley Brethren Home, Palmyra. His loving wife of 71 years, Rosemary Heisey Fry, was by his side when he passed away. Born in Annville on June 10, 1920, Eden was the son of the late John B. and Martha B. Shiffer Fry. He proudly served in the US Navy during WWII aboard the LST828. He worked many years for Atlantic Richfield in Orbisonia and later in Mechanicsburg. Eden was a devoted family man; he and Rosemary together raised four children and made many life-long friends. He was a member of the Fishburn United Methodist Church in Hershey, the American Legion and the Pennsylvania and U.S. LST Association. Eden was loved, admired and respected by his four surviving children; Robert Fry, June Fry, Mary Brillhart and Lois Parker. One of his greatest joys was spending time with his seven grandchildren and four great grandchildren. He is survived by a brother Carl Fry and a sister Claribel Gingrich.
