Edward C. Hummel, 75, of Jonestown, passed away on Wednesday, August 10, 2016, at WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon. He has been the companion of Lois Rank for 31 years.

Born in Royalton on October 11, 1940, he was the son of the late William H. and Lilly Millie Fidler Hummel.
