Edward B. "Ed" McIntyre, 70, of Annville, passed away peacefully on Friday, February 14, 2020 at The Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Marilyn J. (Leister) McIntyre, with whom he celebrated 43 years in marriage.

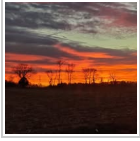
