Edward P. Kohr, 78, of Myerstown, passed away on Thursday, March 7, 2024, at the WellSpan Ephrata Community Hospital. He was the husband of Janet M. Houser Kohr. On August 5th they celebrated their 56th wedding anniversary.

Born in Jonestown on June 18, 1945, he was the son of the late Kermit and Eva Gettle Kohr. Following high school, he served in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam Conflict. He then retired from Hershey Chocolate in 2007, where he had worked in the Maintenance Dept. He was a member of the Palmyra Quigley Baum American Legion Post 72 and the Palmyra Sportsmen's Assoc. He enjoyed hunting and fishing, dirt track racing and especially spending time with his family.
