Edward John Surotchak, 77, of York, died Friday, June 30, 2017 at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Christine (DuGuay) Surotchak, with whom he would have shared 52 years of marriage this December.

Born in Lansford, PA on February 27, 1940, he was the son of the late Edward and Julia (Sabol) Surotchak.
