Elaine W. Fair, 89, of Palmyra passed away on Saturday April 1, 2023 at Londonderry Village. She was the wife of Donald E. Fair, with whom she celebrated 66 years in marriage.

Elaine was born in Reistville on January 21, 1934 to the late John J. and Selma (King) Wenger. She was a 1951 Lebanon High School graduate, and a 1955 Millersville State Teachers College graduate, where she received her BS in elementary education. She started teaching in Lebanon School District, then continued her teaching career in the Annville-Cleona School District, retiring in 1996 after 29 ½ years. She was an active lifetime member of Annville Church of the Brethren. She was also a member of Lebanon County Teachers Honor Society, and Delta Kappa Gamma. Elaine enjoyed watching and listening to Phillies baseball games, Penn State football, and watching hockey. She was a prolific writer and sender of cards to people. She also enjoyed hosting family gatherings and visiting with friends and family.

Thousand of hours were logged by her as a volunteer at Londonderry Village.
