



## Eleanor Bittle Sholley

January 9, 1919 - June 16, 2009

Eleanor Bittle Sholley, 90, of the Lebanon Valley Brethren Home, Palmyra died there on Tuesday June 16, 2009. She was the wife of the late Retired Master Sgt. Milton L. "Mick" Sholley who died in 2005. Born in Schuylkill Haven on January 9, 1919, she was the daughter of the late William F., Sr. and Mamie Straub Bittle. She served as a secretary for the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the State Department, and the Department of Defense.
