Elizabeth M. Ruffner, 97, was born on August 26, 1918 in Madera, PA, to Mary Grace Rickard McCreadie and James McCreadie. She was a 1936 graduate of Bigler Twp. High School, a 1937 graduate of Ina-Del Marvin Beauty School in Detroit, Michigan. She had one of the first beauty shops in Madera for nearly 50 years. She also worked for several funeral homes in Madera, Ramey, Lebanon, and surrounding towns. Elizabeth married James E. Ruffner in May 8, 1937, who preceded her in death on April 12, 2004 at their winter home in Bradenton, FL.
