



## Elizabeth B. 'Sis' Fernsler

March 30, 1911 - September 12, 2008

Elizabeth B. "Sis" Fernsler, age 97, died on September 12, 2008, at the Lebanon Valley Home, where she was a resident since May. Born March 30, 1911, to Bertha (Shuey) and Grant Soliday, she grew up in Lebanon and graduated from Independent Borough High School. She married Sam Fernsler and moved to Annville to the Fernsler farm in the 1930's, lived there for 40 years and later moved to Mt.
